
Dear Mr. Bagwell and Associates:

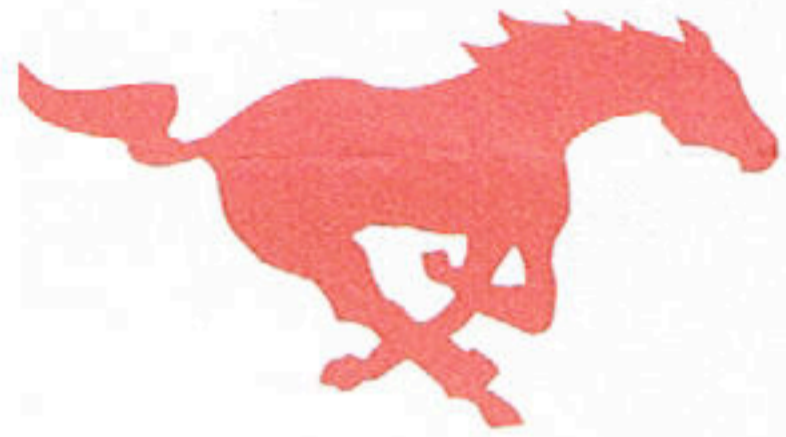
Thank you for your gift. Thank you for being such a friend to Grapevine High School. How blessed we are to have you in our community.
